



Terms and Conditions. Super Bowl 55 Tickets Raffle

1. The promoter of the raffle to be carried out at the Odeon, Harcourt Street, Dublin 2 on 2 Feb 2020 or 3 Feb 2020 (as the case may be) (the “competition”) is Dublin Rebels American Football Club (the “promoter”).
2. The competition relates to a raffle in which all entrants will be afforded a chance, through the random drawing of lots, to win two (2) tickets to Super Bowl LV (the “prize”), to be presented to the winner of the competition by the promoter in co-operation with Anheuser Busch at a time and in a manner as shall be agreed between Anheuser Busch and the winner of the competition.
3. The proceeds of the raffle will be used for the sporting, community, and fundraising purposes of the Dublin Rebels, and no person shall derive personal profit therefrom.
4. The winners of the prize will be determined by the random drawing of lots (the “draw”) in public at halftime during the screening of Super Bowl LIV on 2 Feb 2020 at the Odeon, Harcourt Street, Dublin 2, or on 3 Feb 2020 as the case may be.
5. By purchasing an entry to the competition, an entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.
6. The Promoter is not established or conducted for gaming, wagering or lotteries.
7. Entry to the competition is open to any person over 18 years of age with legal capacity to contract.
8. The cost of an entry to the competition is €10.
9. Only persons who have purchased a draw ticket, or otherwise validly acquired a draw ticket directly from the promoter, are eligible to participate in the competition draw.

10. The promoter reserves the right to limit the maximum number of entries to the draw that can be made by, or on behalf of, an entrant.
11. The competition, and these terms and conditions, are subject to the requirements of Irish law relating to gaming and lotteries, including-
 - a. the Gaming and Lotteries Act 1956 (as amended), and
 - b. any license(s) issued under the Gaming and Lotteries Act 1956 (as amended), including license dated 13 December 2019 granted by Inspector John Finucane.
12. These terms and conditions, and any questions of application or interpretation thereof arising in relation to the Promoter, are governed exclusively by Irish Law. Any provision of these terms and conditions which is inconsistent with Irish law shall be severed from the terms and conditions without affecting in any way the remaining parts of the terms and conditions that are not inconsistent.
13. No refunds will be issued to in respect of entries to the competition, except in the case of the cancellation of the competition, in which case refunds may be provided at the discretion of the promoter.
14. Each entrant may qualify for additional prizes subject to the outcome of the draw, as determined by the Promoter at the time of the draw and subject to the Gaming and Lotteries Act 195 (as amended).
15. Neither the Trustees, committee, or any member of the Promoter, including the organisers of the competition, shall be liable to any person for any loss, material or otherwise, suffered by any person participating in the draw.
16. The prize is as stated, and does not have any equivalent or exchangeable cash value. No substitutions, exchanges, or other alternative value will be offered in lieu of the prize. The Promoter reserves the right to add additional prizes to the draw.
17. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not validly registered or received by the system put in place by the Promoter for the management and receipt for whatever reason. The promoter accepts no responsibility for late, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, corrupted or misdirected entries, claims or correspondence whether due to error, omission, alteration, tampering, deletion, theft, destruction, transmission interruption, communications failure or otherwise.

18. The Promoter reserves the right to change the date of the draw due to any unforeseen circumstances.
19. The Promoter reserve the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of any unforeseen circumstances or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the Promoter's control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible.
20. The Promoter's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into in respect of the competition or the draw.
21. The winner of the draw shall be the person whose unique ticket code corresponds with the code randomly selected in the Draw. In relation to tickets bought by one person on behalf of a group of people, the Promoter expects the person who made the purchase to assign the unique codes accompanying their order to the individuals in the group. In the event that unique codes are not assigned to individuals in this manner, the winner of the Draw shall be the named purchaser of the group of tickets.
22. The winning ticket and the ticket holder(s) will be subject to verification by the Promoter and their agents.
23. The winner will be notified in writing within 28 days of the draw date. If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within 10 days of notification, Dublin Rebels reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner, by means of a supplementary draw or otherwise.
24. The winner of the prize agrees to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material to be used or shared with other users by the promoter.
25. Any personal data relating to the winner or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current Irish data protection legislation and the promoter's data protection policy and will not be disclosed to a third party without the entrant's prior consent.
26. The Promoter shall not be liable for any failure in the performance of any of its obligations if caused by factors outside its control.
27. The implementation, conduct, and verification of this draw will be independently observed by a suitably qualified accountant or person with similar independence and professional expertise to carry out such verification.
28. The prize is not transferable to a person other than the winner of the draw under any circumstances.
29. An entry into the draw is not transferable to a person other than the person in whose name the entry was purchased.
